Sustainability Projects

L’Oreal has set very aggressive sustainability goals for 50% reductions in water, transportable waste, and CO₂ emissions by 2015. The Solon manufacturing site has made great strides in stepping up to the challenge. Using 2005 as the baseline, Solon has already achieved the transportable waste goal, and is very close on CO₂. 2011 marked a year of great progress for water reductions. The program will present some key successful projects followed by questions, answers and tour.

Mr. Marting is the Environmental Manager at L’Oreal USA’s Solon Manufacturing plant. He is responsible for administrating the site’s environmental program, ISO-14001 system, sustainability improvement initiatives, and overseeing the site’s waste, water, and CO₂ reduction efforts. For the past 7 years he worked as L’Oreal Solon’s facilities project engineer, responsible for a plant wide physical renovation, including water, energy, and waste reduction projects. Mr. Marting holds a Bachelors Degree in Chemical Engineering from Ohio University.
